

CAT PROFILE for THE PURRING PARROT®

Mandatory Requirements to stay at The Purring Parrot: If your cat is found to have fleas or ticks treatment will be applied at Owner's expense. We require that you confirm that your cat is in good health and free from and has not been exposed to rabies, or any contagious illness with 30 days prior to starting their stay at The Purring Parrot. Cats with infectious diseases such as distemper or upper respiratory disease will not be allowed. All cats over 4 months of age must be spayed or neutered.

Highly Recommended but not required: An annual exam and an **FVRCP vaccine**, which is like a kitty flu shot, for air borne viruses and can be giving every 3 years after boosters. If your cat does get easily stressed their immune system could be compromised and the **FVRCP vaccine** could help fight off any kitty colds.
